



PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT

The Boys Of Summer Athletic Club was founded on the principles of discipline, motivation, organization, teamwork, morality, respect and a good attitude. We're here to learn baseball and to improve as young adults. Parents are an essential part of our organization, and we want to address their roles as part of our TEAM.

Parents have one job at our games and that is to cheer and support their son and his teammates in a positive manner. Too often we see parents yelling at their son, umpires, opposing teams or coaches. It is hard to teach proper values and respect for the game when, some of the parents do not adhere to the same basic beliefs. So with that said the following rules and consequences are in effect.

No yelling at umpires or opposing teams

No talking to coaches during a game

No talking to your child during a game

No parent or grandparent in or within 20 feet of the dugout during a game

No parent or grandparent is permitted on the field during a game

As far as the last two on the list exceptions can be made if your presence is requested by a member of the coaching staff.

A parent or grandparent questioning a coach about playing time during or immediately following a game is also unacceptable and will not be tolerated.

We do not mind answering those questions, but we ask that you observe what we call the "24 hour rule". Also if your child has an issue or concern about his playing time he should first speak to his coach directly. These are not little boys we are dealing with any more but young men and they will be treated as such.

When at tournaments locally or out of town, we will act accordingly, both at ball fields and hotels. You and your child are representing the Boys Of Summer.

If a rule is violated or your behavior is unbecoming of our organization, your ***son will be benched for 1 game***. If there is a second occurrence, your ***son will be benched for 2 consecutive games***. If there is a third occurrence, ***you will be asked to leave the organization without finishing the season. If you are asked to leave the organization, there will be no refund of any monies.***
